The Mardi Gras Parade will kick off at **4:00 PM**, starting at the intersection of **Edison Street and Washington Avenue** traveling down Washington Avenue, and concluding at the War Memorial at **Walnut Street**. Participants of all kinds—whether floats, golf carts, bands, dance teams, or individuals in costume—are encouraged to join in the fun. PARADE ENTRY RULES & REGULATIONS

- Any entry deemed in poor taste or offensive to the general public will not be allowed to participate. Keep in
 mind the parade is family friendly and every unit should be appropriate for this audience. We will not tolerate
 any sort of vulgar or provocative dancing, music, or acts of mischief. The organizers reserve the right to pull
 anyone from the parade or block party at any time if acting inappropriately.
- All parade participants are encouraged to gently toss beads, candy, or relative small items to attendees.
- Each unit must have an entry form and parade number. Parade entry numbers will be assigned and sent to the contact name on the entry registration. It is the contact's responsibility to share that number and all parade information with all parties in the unit.
- The parade contact is responsible for informing drivers of the entry number, line-up locations, and pick-up area.
- Parade lineup will be organized on Edison Street, next to the courthouse. Parade route will begin at the corner of Edison and Washington and end at the corner of Walnut and Washington.
- Parade order is up to the sole discretion of the parade organizers.
- It is the responsibility of each entry to maintain a reasonable pace to eliminate gaps in the flow of the parade.
- Any parade entry with children under the age of 18 must have adult supervision on the float/entry at all times. Adult supervision must be someone other than the driver.
- All entrants must carry adequate insurance coverage and be driven by a competent, licensed driver.
- Organizers reserve the right to refuse any entry.
- No refunds once paid
- ATVs (including four wheelers and side by sides) are not allowed due to safety. Golf carts and motorcycles are permissible. If you are unsure about your parade entry, please contact the Chamber with questions.

VENDOR ENTRY RULES & REGULATIONS

- Vendors will be assigned a booth number and location. A map will be provided to you prior to the event.
- Booth spaces will be marked and must match your booth number
- No refunds once paid
- All events will be outdoors, even in the event of rain. There will be no reimbursement of vendor payment due to inclement weather.
- Vendors must keep everything within their assigned space.
- Electrical power will not be provided. If you require power, please contact the Chamber.
- If you require a generator, you must gain approval from the Chamber prior to event
- Vendors can begin setting up at 1pm and must be set up BEFORE 4:00 PM
- Vendors must remain open from **4:00 7:00 PM**
- Vendors are responsible for their own tables, chairs, tents, and signage.
- We request that vendors limit their items to Mardi Gras culture inspired themes
- Event organizers reserve the right to refuse any vendor application
- NO BEER, LIQUOR, OR ALCOHOL OF ANY FORM CAN BE SERVED OR SOLD WITHOUT PRIOR CONSENT FROM WCEA/CHAMBER DIRECTOR. YOU WILL BE REMOVED IF YOU SERVE/SELL ALCOHOL WITHOUT THE PROPER PERMITS, LICENSES, AND CONTRACT.
